Robotics and healthcare innovator Keller Rinaudo is showing the world how drone technology saves lives.

He is the CEO and co-founder of Zipline, a company that leverages cutting-edge technology to deliver life-saving medical supplies on demand to healthcare centers and patients in the most remote parts of the world.

You'll hear about Zipline's groundbreaking partnership with Rwanda that will ultimately allow each of the country's 11 million citizens a 15- to 30-minute delivery of any essential medical product they need — no matter where they live. In 2019, Zipline expanded into Ghana, covering 2,000 health facilities and hospitals and facilitating the instant delivery of more than 150 different medical products there.

Prior to Zipline, Keller, a Harvard graduate, built computers out of RNA and DNA that can operate in human cells as molecular doctors. He published this research in *Nature Biotechnology*, becoming one of the youngest first authors in the publication's history.
